They also took part in a technical tour, organised by the Research Section of the Forestry Division and visited the following centres—Roundwood and Avondale Forests, Shelton Abbey, Johnstown Castle, Kilsheelan, Cahir, Clogheen, Cappoquin and Tuamgraney Forests, Kinnitty Forest School and Forest and the Bórd na Mona peat station at Boora.
